- 2.5 Cumulative GPA

- Recipient of a DCF waiver or Homeless Fee Exemption
- Age 18-26 and expecting to graduate prior to age 28
- Attending a school in Florida

\*We accept VOTECH students on a case by case basis



#### Transition to Adulthood.

- Any foster youth aged 14 to 24 in out-of-home care or EFC/PESS residing in or managed from Orange, Osceola or Seminole County.
- Connecting youth to available community resources, programs and assistance through mentorship and personalized support.
- Their team of advocates will provide one-on-one guidance in life skills and transitioning to adulthood.


